SUCCESSFUL ADVOCACY

- NSAC passed the first pharmaceutical and sharps Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) bill in the U.S. in CA, with a 39-0 vote off the Senate Floor.
- In 2017, NSAC sponsored and passed a bill to improve the carpet stewardship program in CA, resulting in the siting of the Aquafil nylon 6 recycling plant in the Sacramento area and the creation of 50+ green jobs. In 2019, NSAC sponsored and passed another bill to ensure the stewardship fee money, the collectors, and the recyclers are protected.
- In 2019, NSAC sponsored and passed a bill to remove the barriers to local governments household hazardous waste reuse programs.
- During the 2020 legislative session, NSAC is sponsoring SB 424 to ban the sale of single-use tobacco products, and require take-back of rechargeable e-cigarettes, funded by the producers.
- Assisted local governments pass ordinances requiring producers to fund and operate take-back programs for their products.
