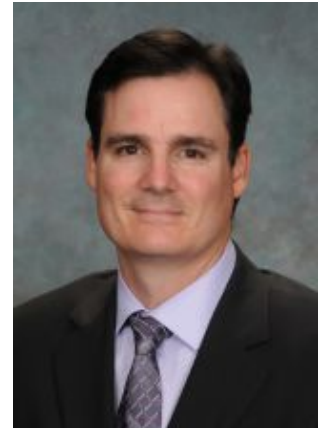


Michael Rock
